Subject: Piggy Back Contract for Sulfuric Acid

I respectfully present the following Comprehensive Analysis to the Village Manager.

The Town of Jupiter has recently awarded a contract with Shrieve Chemical, Inc for the procurement of Sulfuric Acid. The Village would like to use the existing contract to piggy back for these reasons:

1. The cost for the product from Shrieve was lower than the other providers.
2. The product that Shrieve produces meets the NSF/ANSI 60 Drinking Water Standard and all applicable requirements.

Cost: \$12,358.80
