RESOLUTION 90-15, A RESOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING PIGGYBACKING THE CONTRACT BETWEEN AMERICAN WATER CHEMICALS, INC. AND THE TOWN OF JUPITER FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANTISCALANT

WHEREAS, pricing is piggybacked on the Town of Jupiter's contract No. (W1432F);

WHEREAS, this good/service was procured with the same level of formality as the Village would have otherwise required in its Purchasing Policies and Procedures;

WHEREAS, a copy of the agreement is attached to this Resolution;

WHEREAS, this contract will expire on September 30, 2017;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u> Resolution No. 90-15 is hereby awarding a blanket purchase order to American Water Chemicals, Inc for the purchase of Antiscalant at the price of \$0.765 per pound;
