ORDINANCE 9-18, FIRST READING, AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA, FLORIDA, IMPOSING A MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF NEW APPLICATIONS, AND THE ISSUANCE OF ANY VILLAGE PERMITS OR APPROVALS CURRENTLY OUTSTANDING AND REQUIRED FOR PENDING APPLICATIONS, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES WITHIN THE VILLAGE AS SET FORTH IN THE TELECOMMUNICATIONS ACT OF 1996, SEC. 337.401 *FLORIDA STATUTES*, CHAPTER 63 ART. II OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA CODE OF ORDINANCES, AND CHAPTER 78, ZONING, OF THE VILLAGE OF TEQUESTA LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE; PROVIDING THAT SAID MORATORIUM SHALL BE IN EFFECT FOR A PERIOD OF ONE YEAR; DIRECTING VILLAGE STAFF TO UNDERTAKE A COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF THE VILLAGE'S EXISTING TELECOMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES REGISTRATION AND PERMITTING CODES WITH AN EMPHASIS ON THE PROTECTION OF RESIDENTIAL PROPERTIES, AND COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL AND STATE REQUIREMENTS; PROVIDING FOR CONTINUATION OR TERMINATION OF SAID MORATORIUM; PROVIDING A CONFLICTS CLAUSE AND A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.
